OPEN ACCESS CONSUMER

- A person permitted to use intra-State transmission system or receive supply of electricity from a person other than the distribution licensee of his area of supply.
- any time exceeds 1 MW subject to the satisfaction of the conditions supply of electricity where the maximum power to be made available at Open access shall be allowed in the phase I to all consumers requiring a contained in the Act and these regulations.

Impact of Open Access Consumers On DNHPDCL

 Daily Power scheduling by the DNHPDCL shall be disturbed as open access consumers procure power from outside and which will results into power surrendering by DNHPDCL which will lead to burden on other industries.

mpact of Open Access Consumers Or DNHPDCL Contd...

- Approximately, 300 MW is targeted in open access for FY 2016-17. This is more than 45% of the cumulative demand of the DNHPDCL.
- Open Access consumers have dual advantage of receiving power either from outside or from DNHPDCL as and when required. This results into unnecessary capacity blocking by DNHPDCL.

Subject: Open access - Cross burden on other consumers.

Sir,

This has reference to the meeting of yesterday, i.e. 01.03.16, held in the chamber of Executive Engineer, DNH PDCL, regarding Open Access permission to certain consumers.

The data shown to the Associations, regarding fixed charges paid and recovered, though was not clear, but puts a burden of around Rs. 14 Crore on other consumers.

In this connection, the declared policy of Associations has been that, open access is a welcome phenomenon, as it provides opportunity to purchase cheapest available power

to consumers, but at the same time, advantage of one consumer should not become disadvantage of other consumers.

In this connection, we submit:

- a. DNH PDCL should on war footing surrender 200 MW power, so that, fixed charge should be reduced. Right now, it is paying fixed charges at 1050 MW, while our regular consumption is less than 650 MW. Therefore, contact load of 850 MW should be a safe preposition. It will cut down fixed charge immediately.
- b. Saving (a) above, if, DNH PDCL still has to pay some charges or is forced to, buy some minimum quantity of power under various agreements and so purchased power is sold at loss in open market, such burden should be loaded only to concerned open access consumers proportionately and in no case to other consumers.
- DNH PDCL be directed to seek Hon'ble JERC's approval to allow it to charge additional cost from open access consumers.
- d. Any open access consumer, who wants to surrender the power, should not be insisted upon minimum charge for seven years. The provisions of supply code should be followed. The supply code provides, that, minimum demand charges

should be insisted upon only two years, if they have not used power even for those two years. Those who have used power and paid bills for two years should not be asked for minimum charge.

e. Till clarity is worked out, it is desirable to maintain status quo and in no case other consumers should be put to disadvantage because of open access facility provided to certain consumers.

An early action is requested.
