Ref.: Order dated 25.05.2026 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 6174 of 2023 regarding enforcement of SWM Rules 2026.

C I R C U L A R

The SWM Rules 2026 provides a centralized online portal developed by the CPCB for registration, monitoring and compliance of Bulk Waste Generators (BWG) wherein registration on the portal has been made mandatory.

To facilitate registration and create awareness regarding the provisions of the SWM Rules, 2026 and the BWG Online Registration Portal, an Awareness Programme on Portal Registration has been scheduled as per the details given below:

Date: 11.06.2026 (Thursday)

Time: 11:00 AM onwards

Venue: Dr.APJ Abdul Kalam Auditorium, Dadra & Nagar Haveli

As per the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, a Bulk Waste Generator includes any entity having:

- Built-up area of 20,000 sq. metres or more, or
- Water consumption of 40,000 litres per day or more, or
- Solid waste generation of 100 kg per day or more.

Therefore, all concerned Bulk Waste Generators are hereby directed to depute a responsible representative to attend the programme and complete their online registration on the Centralized BWG Portal within the stipulated timeline. All Associations, Industrial Units, Hotels, Institutions, Hospitals, Commercial Establishments and Residential Societies are requested to circulate this information among their members and ensure timely compliance.

Program Briefing:

All Industries, Hotels, Institutions, Commercial Establishments, Hospitals, Educational Institutions and other entities falling under the category of Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs) are hereby informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court, while reviewing the implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, has directed strict enforcement of the Rules with special emphasis on identification, registration and monitoring of Bulk Waste Generators through the centralized online portal. The Court has emphasized that compliance by BWGs shall be complete and mandatory.

The programme is being organized in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India issued on 25.05.2026 in Civil Appeal No. 6174 of 2023 regarding the implementation and enforcement of the Bulk Waste Generator (BWG) Online Registration System under the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed all States, Union Territories, Urban Local Bodies, Panchayati Raj Institutions, Pollution Control Boards and other concerned authorities to ensure registration of eligible Bulk Waste Generators on the designated online portal and to undertake necessary awareness, capacity-building and compliance measures for effective implementation of the Rules. Accordingly, an Awareness Programme, Portal Registration Training Session is being organized to facilitate registration of Bulk Waste Generators and to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026.

The programme shall cover:

1. Overview of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026.
2. Eligibility criteria and responsibilities of Bulk Waste Generators.
3. Online registration process on the BWG Portal.
4. Compliance requirements relating to source segregation, processing of wet waste and scientific disposal of waste.
5. Clarifications and interaction with participating stakeholders.
