

The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi will launch the "Make in India" campaign on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2014 at 10.00 AM in Vigyan Bhavan. It is envisaged as the flagship drive of the Government to make India a major manufacturing hub.

This campaign can be successful only through the involvement of States in the federal structure of the country. It is proposed to engage all the States through a hub-and-spoke programme to take the "Make in India" mission to a larger audience through respective industries.

The Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) has requested CII and FICCI, the apex associations of industry bodies at the national level to assume a larger role in implementation of this programme in States. They have been asked to organize functions at State capitals in India involving the concerned industry associations, chambers of commerce and industry, leading industrialists and businesses and representatives of State Governments to initiate hub-and-spoke programme of "Make in India" coinciding with the national launch of the campaign at New Delhi. The States assigned to these organizations are as at Annex - I.

It is requested to initiate necessary preparations for organizing the event in consultation with the nodal industry association and share the same with DIPP by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2014 on e-mail ID [shubhra.s@nic.in](mailto:shubhra.s@nic.in). A template of the suggested programme, as worked out by CII and FICCI is enclosed for ready reference at Annex-II and Annex - III respectively.
