ORDER U/S. 163 OF THE BHARTIYA NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA, 2023

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that heavy commercial vehicles and goods vehicles are frequently being parked / stationed on the road stretch i.e. 1) Saheed Chowk to Naroли Entrance Gate, 2) on Silvassa Ring Road, 3) Samarvarni to Rakholi road stretch and 4) All the road stretch of National Highway and State Highway passing through Dadra & Nagar Haveli District;

AND WHEREAS, such unauthorised and obstructive parking is causing obstruction to the smooth movement of pedestrian and vehicular traffic, reducing the effective carriageway width, causing traffic congestion and inconvenience to the general public and creating potential risks to road users, particularly during the speak hours;

AND WHEREAS, vehicles parked on public roads in such a manner as to obstruct or impede the free movement of traffic may also cause danger to human life and safety and may adversely affect the movement of vehicles of emergency services including ambulances, fire tenders etc.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 163 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, I, Amit Kumar, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and in the interest of public safety, free movement of traffic and maintenance of public order, the undersigned hereby issues the following directions:

- 1) Road stretches from 1) Saheed Chowk to Naroли Entrance Gate, 2) on Silvassa Ring Road, 3) Samarvarni to Rakholi road stretch and 4) All the road stretches of National Highway and State Highway passing through Dadra & Nagar Haveli District have been declared as "NO PARKING ZONE" for all kinds of heavy commercial vehicles and goods vehicles.
- 2) Any such vehicle found parked in violation of this Order, particularly where it causes obstruction, danger or undue inconvenience to the public, may be removed / towed, wheel-clamped or otherwise immobilised by the competent authority/ traffic authorities, as permissible under law.
- 3) The owner/ driver of such vehicle shall be liable to bear the applicable towing, wheel-clamping, storage and other prescribed charges, in addition to any

penalty/ challan payable under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and rules/ orders made thereunder.

- 4) In case of repeated violation, the enforcement authorities shall take appropriate action under the applicable provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other relevant laws/ rules.
- 5) The registered owner and/or person in charge of such vehicle shall ensure that the vehicle is not parked or left unattended in violation of this Order or applicable traffic regulations.
- 6) Ignorance of this Order shall not be accepted as a justification where the Order has been duly promulgated and reasonable measures have been taken for its public notification.
- 7) The Traffic Police, Transport Department and other concerned enforcement authorities shall undertake regular patrolling and enforcement drives on the road mentioned above and shall take immediate action against vehicles found causing obstruction or danger to the public safety.
- 8) This Order shall not apply to vehicles of Fire & Emergency Services, Ambulances or other emergency / service vehicles when parked temporarily in connection with emergency duties, provided that such parking does not cause avoidable obstruction and is in the course of lawful duty.

Nothing contained in this Order shall prevent the competent authority from taking action under any other applicable provision of law, including the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, applicable Rules, notifications, traffic regulations or local laws.

This Order is issued in the interest of public safety, traffic management, prevention of obstruction and free movement of emergency and other vehicles.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect. This order will be in force from 17/08/2026 to 16/10/2026 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.
