ORDER

(Under Section 144Cr.PC)

WHEREAS information has been received from HO/SPO, NVBDCP that there is a likelihood of outbreak of Malaria, Dengue and other vector borne diseases in the UT of D&NH in the ensuing monsoon season,


AND WHEREAS the reason for such outbreak is the stagnancy of water which is an ideal location for the breeding of mosquitoes,

AND WHEREAS a survey was done by the office of NVBDCP and it was found that there are certain areas such as bars, restaurants, new construction sites, tyre vendors and repairers, industrial premises, scrap dealers etc. which are prone to water logging and breeding of mosquitoes,

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to restrict such water stagnation and all concerned have to take precautionary measures to check any outbreak of vector borne diseases during the monsoon season,


THEREFORE, I, Sandeep Kumar Singh, Collector-cum-District Magistrate, D&NH hereby direct the following under Section 144 Cr.PC;

- a. CEO (DP), CO(SMC), EE(PWD) and (Road) have to ensure that all the potholes, pits etc on roads which are prone to water logging are levelled and filled up.
- b. All residents shall ensure that the water in air-coolers and stored in containers such as drums, buckets or other similar utensils are kept clean and the water shall be changed every seventh day.
- c. The Industrial units that have large number of containers in open place storing rain water and lead to heavy breeding shall ensure no stagnation of water in their premises. The temporary sheds erected with tarpaulin leads to accumulation of rain water and thus breeding and hence shall be ensured that there is no stagnation of water.
- d. It shall be the responsibility of the respective building contractors, government agencies, or any other individual/entity carrying out constructions, to ensure that no water accumulation takes place on any of their construction sites.
- e. Scrap merchants and dealers shall ensure that none of the materials found at their site shall become a source of mosquito breeding. In this regard, they shall ensure that items such as bottles, drums, tyres, etc are not kept in the open as much possible and if in open shall not become sites for breeding.



- f. All bars and restaurants shall ensure that all the water generated by them is properly disposed off. They shall ensure that their neighborhood shall remain clean and waste generated by them shall not contribute to spreading of vector-borne diseases. The bars and restaurants will have to cooperate with NVBDCP officers and workers to see to it that regular fogging and antilarval measures are done in their premises.
- g. The Public Works Department (PWD) shall ensure that sludge is properly disposed off after the completion of their work. They shall pay special attention to correct any leakage in pipelines, and make sure that all manholes are covered.
- h. It shall be the responsibility of the HO/SPO, NVBDCP to take the required steps for spraying of chemicals to prevent any type of mosquito breeding in sites where rain water has a tendency to accumulate. The Officer shall carry out anti-larval activities in the breeding season.
- i. Since mosquitoes find a favourable home in rubber tyres, shops selling tyres or those indulging in repair of tyres, are informed to ensure no water accumulation shall be allowed inside tyres at or near their premises.
- j. The HO/SPO, NVBDCP shall take all required steps to check residential and commercial premises for anti-larval activities. In cases where the concerned officer finds resistance from the owner/occupants of the premises he/she shall take the necessary assistance from the concerned SHO. It shall be the responsibility of the CEO (District Panchayat) and CO (Silvassa Municipal Council) to carry out special drives to find out any violators of the said order, and take necessary action, including registration of a police complaint. A list of all such violators shall be prepared and be shared with the District Magistrate for necessary action.

Code. Any violation shall invite action under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
