



VAT Assessment without waiting Form 'C' verification

Dear Members of Constituent Associations,

Members have approached to their respective Associations with grievance that their Form 'C's, which were submitted for assessment but could not be online verified are being ignored by the VAT dept. and being considered as 'no tax payment'. In fact, some assessment orders have been issued based on this analogy. It means there will be an additional tax liability on members considering such C Forms as bogus.

The Legislation on the subject provides for appeal within 60 days of the order before competent Tribunal. Since, in the U.T of DNH powers have not been delegated to Tribunal appointed (Session Judge), only judicial remedy against above said assessment orders is left, in a form of petition to Hon'ble Bombay High Court. Unfortunately your Association and this Federation will not have any 'locus standi'. Petitions will have to be filled by individual tax payers.

Federation will co-ordinate and motivate tax payers to file in a group.

To discuss pros and cons of this preposition and if approved, develop an action plan, a general meeting of tax payers has been organized on 22/11/18 at 4:30pm at Danudhyog Sahakari Sangh.

If you are one of the affected taxpayers or likely to be affected taxpayers, make sure that you attend the meeting.
