PDCL for the quarter Oct-Dec 16**

These are: Silvassa Industries Association, DNH Industries Association and Silvassa Industries and Manufacturers' Association, These three Associations put together represent more than 1000 electricity consumers, which are mainly in the industrial sector.

With deep regrets, it is submitted that DNH PDCL has determined and imposed FPPCA @ Rs 1.30 paise per unit for the quarter Oct – Dec 16 completely in violation of the Regulations prescribed by the Hon'ble JERC. It is understood that DNH PDCL have not submitted these computations before Hon'ble JERC for approval As DNH PDCL, as per regulations, is duty bound to present computations for the approval of Hon'ble JERC.

Main violation in determination of said FPPCA is that it includes the fixed charges, which have been paid by DNH PDCL on account of non-purchase of power due to open access. It is not the cost of power, but, it is cost of non-purchase of power. It is a cost of stranded power. It is the cost, which, had to be paid because of open access. But, since, DNH PDCL made it part of FPPCA, it has been recovered only from the consumers who have not availed the open access facility. FPPCA is not recovered from the open access consumers.

Hence, Federation requests Hon'ble JERC to investigate the matter and direct DNH PDCL to correct the computations and refund the excess recovery made on account of wrongly determined FPPCA for said quarter and also restrain them not to repeat such wrong computations in future.

If necessary, representatives of Federation would seek permission of Hon'ble JERC to present the case in person.

It is estimated that about Rs 100 crore have wrongly recovered by the distribution licensee from the consumers.

Federation is sure that Hon'ble JERC shall take cognizance of it and initiate appropriate action.


