CIRCULAR

Subject: Addendum of MSME sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme Guidelines.

Ref: Notificaiton No. 17(2)/MSME Champion/ZED/Women/Full Subsidy/2023-24 (comp No. 4025584)

The Ministry of Micro, Small, Medium Enterprises, Government of India, New Delhi has introduce a scheme namely Sustainable (ZED-Zero Defect Zero Effect) Certification Scheme with a view to create awareness amongst MSME's about Zero Defect Zero Effect practices and motivate & incentives them ZED Certification.


In this connection, it is to inform all the MSME's in the U.T. of DNH & DD that an Addendum has been made under Guideline 3.4.5 (B) i.e. Additional Subsidy (Subsidy for Cost of Certification) (copy enclosed) as under:

1. *There will be an additional subsidy of 10% for the MSMEs owned by SC/ST Entrepreneurs OR MSMEs in NER/Himalayan/LWE/Island territories/aspirational districts **other than Women.***
2. *In additional to above, there will be an additional to above, there will be an additional subsidy of 5 % for MSMEs which are also a part of the SFURTI OR Micro & Small Enterprises – Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) of the Ministry **other than Women.***
3. ***There will be 100 % subsidy to the MSMEs owned by Women Entrepreneurs.***

MSMEs may opt for upgrading their Certification Level at any point of time before the expiry of validity of their exiting ZED Certification. Cost and subsidy will remain the same for the applied Level.

Henceforth, women owned MSMEs will be eligible for 100% subsidy and the additional subsidy provisional at point 1 & 2 above of 10% and 5% is inapplicable for them.

The aforesaid addendum shall come into force w.e.f. 11.11.2023 till validity of the scheme

Reference: MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme Guidelines 2022

In supersession of the existing guidelines of MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme 2022 issued as per earlier approvals, clause 3.4.5b relating to subsidy on the cost of ZED certification for the MSMEs owned by women entrepreneurs is hereby amended as follows:

Henceforth, women owned MSMEs will be eligible for 100% subsidy and the additional subsidy provisioned at point 1 & 2 above of 10% and 5% is inapplicable for them.

- The aforesaid addendum shall come into force *w.e.f. 11.11.2023 till the validity of the scheme.*
- This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Union Minister for Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India.
